# Our house is launched – a new chapter begins!





It was great to meet at our annual Community Weekend in January, both in person and online, to officially launch our first community house. The story of L'Arche was told, we remembered devoted past members, and Fr Phillip, Vicar-General of the Adelaide RC church, and Don from St Francis Anglican Church, joined in an ecumenical house blessing.

We also welcomed Tracy Tohl as our first Community Leader where we shared a heartfelt blessing for her as she moves forward in her pivotal community role.

These two very significant events, held around the front garden of our first community house, vividly reminded us that L'Arche Adelaide is transitioning to a new, exciting phase of our development. After exactly nine years of sharing together around meals and activities, praying and planning, we can now see our first house in bricks and mortar, and we can visualise people with and without disabilities living together in community in that place.

And so, we impatiently wait for the NDIS nod of approval for our registration application, so that we can warmly welcome our first people into 9 Dinwoodie Ave, Clarence Gardens, and a house can become a community home.

It brings to fruition the common vision for faith-based community housing that was shared by sixteen people at our first ever meeting in January 2013. - A new chapter in our community emerges, into which we take our first baby steps.

And just as God has blessed and guided us on our journey thus far, may we be assured that God will continue to guide and nurture us as we move forward in community. Thanks be to God.

Money raised will go to our Life Skills and Garden Program for people with disabilities.

#### **Finance & Resources Update**

- We continue the process of setting up our community house at 9 Dinwoodie Ave, Clarence Gardens.
- Our main focus at present is to obtain our NDIS registration which is proving to take longer than we originally anticipated. We need the registration so that we can accept residents into our home & we expect it will take another 2 months before the registration will be obtained due to processing backlogs. Please pray for a speedy conclusion to this issue.
- In the meantime, our Community Leader, Tracy Tohl has been busy over the last 4 months setting up the home. As mentioned elsewhere we have been blessed in essentially furnishing the whole home with donations. We had our L'Arche lunch and meeting in our house on Sunday 27 February which was very enjoyable.
- We continue in paying rent on the house as well as the payment of the salary to Tracy. We are estimating that these expenses will amount to another \$10,000 over the next 2 months before we can commence receiving regular income from our permanent residents.
- We have been blessed with a number of large donations & grants over the last 4 months so a big THANKYOU to everyone assisting us to meet these expenses.
- L'Arche Australia have been providing administration, payroll and accounting services over the last 4 months so a thank you to them in assisting us in our set-up phase.
- The net cash position of L'Arche Adelaide at 22 March 2022 was \$36,675 whereas it was \$43,147 at 5 December 2021, so the bank balance hasn't dropped as much as we had budgeted for.
- L'Arche Adelaide are certainly commencing on a "Venture of Faith" in setting up our first home, but we know that with prayer & support from our members & friends, God will provide during this time.
