Together With and without intellectual disabilities



On behalf of the Nomination Committee, I want to share an update on our process to select an International Leader and Vice International Leader.

Our last updates (by e-mail on January 4, through a series of open calls in late January, and in person at the Extended Leadership meeting in Montreal in March) outlined our work, supported by Mission Talent, to screen and interview potential candidates. This eventually resulted in three final candidates, all external to L'Arche, all with a variety of professional and personal experience related to our work and our mission. Some of you helped us introduce those candidates to L'Arche during our process, meeting with them individually over Zoom, welcoming them to your national online events, inviting them to in-person visits in your communities. We are so grateful for your generosity and openness to support our process in this way.

Very late in the process, one of those three candidates withdrew for personal reasons. Through our discernment, the Nomination Committee determined that a second candidate was not the right match for the role of International Leader at this point. We presented the third candidate to the International Stewardship Board and International Leadership Team, who the Federation voted to delegate the authority to name the next International Leader based on the recommendation of our committee.

After working together over a few weeks, we could not reach consensus with the ISB and ILT about the suitability of the candidate we had recommended, so we decided to withdraw our nomination.

After three years of work, which included two intense rounds of consultation, we remain unable to name an International Leader for the Federation of L'Arche. The ISB and the ILT are strategizing about what this means, and what the appropriate next step is in this important process. This will include determining whether the Nomination Committee or its individual members will continue in their current roles.

We know this news may lead to feelings of concern or disappointment. We want to assure you that the International Stewardship Board and the International Leadership Team are working to ensure that the work of L'Arche International continues with minimum disruption, insecurity, and confusion.

Since June 2023, Sylvain Brabant has been leading the Federation as Interim CEO, and he has generously offered to continue in that role until September, at which point he will resume his role as chair of the ISB.

Once the ISB has determined the next steps in our search for leadership for the Federation, that information will be shared with all of you. Meanwhile, we humbly ask for your continued prayers and support for all those who are responsible to chart the course for the Federation in this time of significant change.

LENTIL SOUP

Ingredients

- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 onion, diced
- 1 large garlic clove, minced
- 1 teaspoon cumin
- 1 teaspoon turmeric
- 1 cup (130 grams) carrots, diced
- 1 cup (130 grams) potatoes, diced
- 1 ½ cup (270 grams) red lentils, rinsed and drained
- 5 cups (1.2 liter) vegetable broth or hot water*
- $\frac{3}{4}$ 1 teaspoon fine salt, or to taste
- 1/8 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper, or to taste
- ½ lemon, juice
- 1 handful cilantro or parsley, chopped



- In a large pot heat gently the olive oil over medium heat. Add the onion and cook for about 5 minutes, until the onion starts to soften.
- Add cumin, turmeric, garlic, and stir for 1 minute until fragrant.
- Then add lentils, carrots, potatoes, and give a good stir.
- Add the broth, salt, and pepper and bring to the boil.
- Reduce the heat, cover with a lid, and simmer for about 20 minutes, stirring occasionally.
- Remove the pot from the heat, check the seasoning and the consistency (you might like a thicker or a thinner soup, so you can add or reduce the amount of liquid
- Optional step: using an immersione blender you can puree the soup until it's smooth and creamy if you wish.
- Serve with chopped parsley or coriander, a pinch of paprika if you like and freshly squeezed lemon juice to taste*.

\$40 million in community funding to boost independence and self advocacy of Australians with disability

The Australian Government is investing \$40 million over two years in self-advocacy and peer support programs so they can continue to support people with disability to engage in our community and to advocate for themselves. The Peer Support and Capacity Building grant program is a one-off grant round available to community-based services to continue the valuable role they play in the community supporting people with disability, families and carers. Minister for the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS), the Hon. Bill Shorten MP said community-based services play a unique role in welcoming people with disability and empowering them to build confidence and advocate for themselves. "Peer support and self-advocacy organizations are central to supporting people with disability to feel connected within our community and to learn from the experience of others," Minister Shorten said. "As we collectively work together to make the NDIS stronger, we all know we're at a critical point of the Scheme's history. This means there's never been a more important time to strengthen the services that support people with disability to engage confidently and self-advocate for what is right for them. "The future of the NDIS is in peer-led work, with support for decision-making at its heart. This is the vision of the NDIS Review – to make sure participants have the power and knowledge to navigate how best to use their NDIS funds.
